Day 4: MELBOURNE - GREAT OCEAN ROAD (B|D)

Victoria's Great Ocean Road breathtaking experience at any time of the year. One of the most beautiful coastal roads in the world, the Great Ocean Road stretches 243 km along the southern coast of Victoria. Day 5: MELBOURNE - CAIRNS (B|D)

Day 6: CAIRNS (B|L|D)
