Itinerary

Day 1: DEPARTURE : LONDON - SIEM REAP

Begin your journey with a comfortable flight from London to Siem Reap. Overnight travel.

Day 2: SIEM REAP (L/D)

Upon arrival, meet Citibond's representative for a transfer to the hotel. Check-in and relax after your journey. Overnight in Siem Reap.

Day 3: SIEM REAP - ANGKOR TEMPLES (B/L/D)

Today, explore the iconic Angkor Wat, Bayon Temple, and Ta Prohm. Visit the Terrace of the Elephants and the South Gate of Angkor Thom. Enjoy an evening immersed in local culture. Overnight in Siem Reap.

Day 4: BANTEY SREI & ANGKOR CIRCUIT (B/L/D)

Morning Tour to visit Srah Srang, Ta Keo, and Preah Khan. Explore Banteay Srei and the local handicraft village in the afternoon. Overnight in Siem Reap.

Day 5: SIEM REAP - HO CHI MINH CITY (B/L/D) (By Flight)

Morning boat trip to Kampong Phluk Floating Village on Tonle Sap Lake. Get transferred to the Siem Reap Airport to catch the flight to Ho Chi Minh City. Overnight in Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 6: HO CHI MINH CITY (B/L/D)

Visit the historic Cu Chi Tunnels, an underground network used during the Vietnam War. Embark on a city tour to explore the War Remnants Museum, Notre Dame Cathedral, and Reunification Palace. Overnight in Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 7: MEKONG DELTA EXCURSION (B/L/D)

Explore the Ham Luong River in a boat, visit coconut workshops, and enjoy local lunch. Return to Ho Chi Minh City. Overnight in Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 8: HO CHI MINH - DA NANG - HOI AN (B/L/D) (By Flight)

In the morning, transfer to the airport for your flight to Da Nang. Upon arrival, continue your scenic journey with a transfer to Hoi An. Explore the UNESCO-

listed Hoi An Old Quarter, a historic trading port, and participate in a lantern-making workshop. Overnight in Hoi An.

Day 9: HOI AN - BA NA HILLS & GOLDEN BRIDGE (B/L/D)

Enjoy the scenic ride to Ba Na Hills via Cable Car. Take a walk on famous Golden Bridge, Linh Ung Pagoda, and have panoramic views of Da Nang. Descend via Cable Car. Overnight in Hoi An.

Day 10: HOI AN - HUE (B/L/D)

Today, depart from Hoi An via the stunning Hai Van Pass, one of the most impressively scenic hillside roads in Vietnam. Arrive in Hue and visit Thien Mu Pagoda. Overnight in Hue.

Day 11: HUE CITY TOUR (B/L/D)

Explore the Imperial City and Hue Citadel, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Visit the Tomb of Emperor Minh Mang. Overnight in Hue.

Day 12: HUE - DMZ - DONG HOI (B/L/D)

Visit Quang Tri Citadel, Hien Luong Bridge, and other Demilitarised Zone landmarks. Continue the journey towards Dong Hoi along with the Ben Hai river. Overnight stay in Dong Hoi.

Day 13: PHONG NHA & PARADISE CAVES (B/L/D)

Get on a short boat trip to explore the stunning limestone formations of Phong Nha Cave. Later, get transferred to visit Paradise cave which is a newly discovered cave in Vietnam and considered as the largest complex of caves in the world. Overnight stay in Dong Hoi.

Day 14: DONG HOI - HANOI (B/L/D) (By Flight)

Today, take the flight to Hanoi. Visit the Hanoi Train Street and enjoy a cyclo (tuk-tuk) tour of the Old Quarter. Overnight stay in Hanoi.

Day 15: HANOI - HALONG BAY (B/L/D)

Two-hour scenic drive to Halong Bay. Cruise onboarding at around 12:00 & enjoy a lunch aboard

Peony Cruise. Participate in the activities like Kayaking at Tra Bau and cooking demonstration. Enjoy sunset views, sky bar, or try squid fishing. Overnight on Halong Bay Cruise.

Day 16: HALONG BAY - HANOI (B/L/D)

On the cruise, Start the day with a Tai Chi session. Tour of Cat Ba Biosphere and Trung Trang Cave. Return to Hanoi & disembark from the cruise. In the afternoon visit to the Temple of Literature. Overnight stay in Hanoi.

Day 17: HANOI - LUANG PRABANG (B/L/D) (By Flight)

Get transferred to the airport for the flight to Luang Prabang. Evening at leisure in this UNESCO-listed town. Overnight stay in Luang Prabang.

Day 18: LUANG PRABANG BOAT CRUISE (B/L/D)

Today, enjoy a long-tail boat cruise along the Mekong River to its confluence with the Nam-Ou River, stopping at Ban Chan village to observe traditional pottery making. Continue to explore Wat Xiengman and Wat Longkhoun before cruising through the picturesque Laotian countryside, passing local villages. Arrive at the Pak Ou Caves, a fascinating cave system filled with countless Buddha statues left by pilgrims over generations. Stop at Ban Sanghai to observe the traditional rice wine distillation process. Overnight stay in Luang Prabang.

Day 19: CULTURAL TOUR & KUANG SI WATERFALL (B/L/D)

Explore the UNESCO World Heritage city of Luang Prabang, rich in culture and history. Visit Wat Xieng Thong, the Royal Palace, and Mount Phousi. Experience the serene culture of Luang Prabang. Explore Kuang Si Waterfall and the Bear Rescue Centre. Overnight stay in Luang Prabang.

Day 20: DEPART TO LONDON (B)

Transfer to the airport for your flight back home.
