

# SEVEN SISTERS OF NORTH EAST WITH KOLKATA – 16 DAYS

**Depart Date: 15/09/2024, 07/11/2024**

**Return Date: 20/09/2024, 22/11/2024**

## Itinerary:

### **Day 1: London to Kolkata:**

Take flight from London Heathrow to Kolkata:

### **Day 2 Kolkata Arrival:**

Arrival at Kolkata airport, Pickup and transfer to hotel. Check-in at hotel. Overnight stay.

### **Day 3 Kolkata Sightseeing, Kali Mata Temple:**

After breakfast, Visit Kali Mata Temple. Later proceed for Guided panoramic city tour Of Kolkata's famous places - Victoria Memorial, Howrah Bridge, Birla Temple, Fort William, Belur Math. Overnight stay.



### **Day 4 Kolkata to Guwahati (by Flight), Kamakhya Devi Temple**

After breakfast transfer to airport for flight to Guwahati. Pickup and proceed to visit famous Kamakhya Temple on the Nilachal Hills (10kms) – a seat of the tantric cult in India and one of the Shakti Pethas in the country. Later transfer to hotel. Check-in at hotel. Overnight stay.

### **Day 5 Guwahati - Dirang sightseeing**

After breakfast drive to Dirang visit the Kiwi & Apple Gardens. After viewing the beautiful valley of Dirang overlooking the river and inhabited by colorful tribes, proceed towards the Sela Pass (13703 ft) spend some lovely times by the paradise lake. Overnight stay.

### **Day 6 Dirang to twang**

After breakfast drive to Tawang- on arrival check-in at Hotel. Overnight stay.

### **Day 7 Tawang**

After breakfast explore Tawang Monastery, founded by Mera Lama Lodre Gyaltsso during 17th Century A.D. a contemporary of the fifth Dalai Lama and visit Maduri lake (PTso Lake), China Border & The Tawang Gompa is definitely the high point of the town, with a commanding view

of the splendid valleys beyond. Also visit the War memorial. Evening free for shopping and leisure. Overnight stay.

#### **Day 8 Tawang – Bomdila ( 185 kms 07 hrs approx.)**

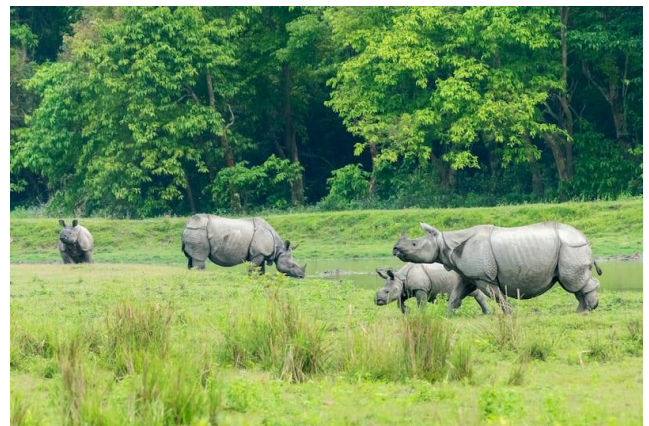
Early morning, drive to Jang to get a breath taking view of waterfalls. Pay homage at the Jashwant Garh Indo Chinese War Memorial and downhill drive (185km, 7hrs) to Bomdila, Overnight stay.

#### **Day 9 Bomdila – Kaziranga**

After breakfast check out from the Hotel and visit Bomdila Monastery & Apple Orchids and then proceed to Kaziranga. Reached Kaziranga check in at city hotel & Evening Enjoy Assam Cultural program. Overnight stay.

#### **Day 10 Jungle activities at Kaziranga national park**

After an early wake up, you will be taken to the riding point in the Central Range (Kohora) for an Elephant Ride. After the ride, return back to the Hotel. After breakfast, drive to the Central Range (Kohora) of the park for a jeep safari. Evening visit Kaziranga Orchid and Biodiversity Park & Tea Garden. Overnight stay.



#### **Day 11 Kaziranga – Shillong**

Today Morning after Breakfast check out from the hotel and drive towards Shillong, also known as 'The Scotland of the East' is the capital city of Meghalaya. En route you will visit the largest manmade lake of Northeast India – Uiam Lake. Evening free for leisure or for shopping in the famous Police Bazaar in Shillong. Overnight stay.

#### **Day 12 Shillong – Mawlynnong-Dawki – Shillong**

Wake up early and have your breakfast and drive to Mawlynnong. Today you can explore the village Mawlynnong in the world. You can take the sky walk. Spectacular view of the living Root Bridge. After lunch drive to Dawki. Dawki is the gateway to Bangladesh where major export and import transactions take place. it is a splendid drive of 45 kilometres passing through deep gorges and ravines, which is certainly a thrilling experience. On approaching Dawki is the Umngot river, the Umngot river is the natural boundary between Ri Pnar or Jaintia Hills with Hima Khyrim of Khasi hills over which is a single span suspension bridge was constructed. Later back to Shillong. Overnight stay.

#### **Day13 Shillong – Cherrapunjee- Shillong**

Early Morning after breakfast drive to Cherrapunjee which is famed for being the wettest place in the world. First visit Elephant Falls later drive to Cherapunjee. After a drive of 1 ½ hours amid pine trees and mists we reach Cherrapunjee. Cherrapunjee possesses some exotic waterfalls

and impressive limestone caves. In Cherrapunji, we visit the Nohkalikai Falls, seven sister falls, Mawsmai Caves, Arwa Cave, Mawsmai Falls, Eco Park. Overnight stay.

#### **Day 14 Shillong to Guwahati**

Morning after breakfast Drive to Guwahati- on arrival check-in at Hotel. Overnight stay.

#### **Day 15 Guwahati- Kolkata (by Flight):**

Early Morning after breakfast visit India's Longest Ropeway, Chakreshwar Temple, Balaji Temple, Nabagrah, Sri Shankardeva Kalakshetra-a cultural center with a fine exposition of the life and culture of the people of Assam. Afternoon transfer to airport connect flight for Kolkata, on arrival transfer to Hotel. Overnight stay.

#### **Day: 16 Kolkata Departure**

After breakfast check out from the hotel and transfer to airport for onward flight
