Itinerary:

Day 1: London to Trivandrum:

Take a flight from London Heathrow airport to Trivandrum.

Day 2 Trivandrum Arrival:

Arrival at Trivandrum airport. Pickup and transfer to hotel. Check-in at hotel. Overnight say.


Day 3: Trivandrum & Kovalam Sightseeing:

After breakfast proceed to excursion for Trivandrum, where you go for sightseeing of Sree Padmanabha Swami Temple, Kuthiramalika Palace Museum, The Napier Museum, Sree Chithra Art Gallery, Zoological Park, Science & Technology Museum, Kanakakunnu Palace, Planetarium. After the Trivandrum sightseeing tour, we shall return to Kovalam. Overnight stay.

Day 4: Kovalam to Kumarakom (175 kms / 04 hrs Approx.)

After Breakfast at the hotel and drive to kumarakom. On arrival, check-in to hotel. Later we shall visit

Kumarakom Bird Sanctuary. It is an excellent place to hear the birds chirping sound along with witnessing unique flora and fauna. Kumarakom Bird Sanctuary is the favorite hotspot for



Day 5: Kumarakom sightseeing – Thekkady (120 hrs / 03 hrs Approx.)

After early breakfast you will be taken to visit the one-of-a-kind Bay Island Driftwood Museum. Take a boat ride to Pathiramanal Island to marvel at the intriguing variety of plants, animals and birds, the zoo, and the natural aquarium. Day 6: Thekkady sightseeing – Munnar (90 kms / 02 hrs. approx.)

Overnight stay.

Day 7: Munnar Sightseeing

After breakfast you will be taken for full day sightseeing of Munnar. Enjoy panoramic views of Anamudi, the highest peak of South India at 2695 m, visible from Munnar. Visit the Christ Church and proceed for wildlife watching at Eravikulam National Park (16 km). Note: Park would be closed from 01Jan to 28 Feb every year Continue to Rajamalai Hills lying adjacent to the park and stop by at Madupetty Dam, a famous picnic spot for boating and horse riding en route to Top Station. Evening transfer to hotel. Overnight stay.



Day 8: Munnar to Cochin (125 kms / 02 hrs. Aprox.), Cochin Sightseeing

Morning after Breakfast at the hotel and drive to Cochin. On arrival, check-in to hotel. Later you will be taken for sightseeing of Cochin ihn which you will visit Fort Kochi, an old town in the south-western section of Kochi, offers colonial charm and tradition. And enjoy viewing its unique colonial architecture as you drive through the city. Finally, enjoy your lunch at Panjim.

Post lunch and head to Baga Beach to enjoy water sports, and then you can go on a shopping spree at the Tibetan market. Overnight stay.

Day 11: Goa

Morning after breakfast you will be free for you independent activity in which you can spend time on the beaches of Goa. Overnight stay.

Day 12: South Goa Sightseeing:

After breakfast, head towards South Goa. Today, you will be sightseeing the major attractions

of South Goa. Tourist attractions that you will cover include Margo and Largo de Igreja. Later proceed to "Ancestral Goa," a re-creation of Goan rural life. The village has several artifact centers, art galleries, and open-air museums.

Now it's time to visit the grand house -Menezes Braganza house, in Chandor. This house also has a library with 5,000 leatherbound books personally collected by Luis de



Menezes Braganza (1878-1938), a reputed journalist well-known for playing a pivotal role in Goa's independence movement. After the long sightseeing tour of South Goa, head back to the hotel. Overnight stay.

Day 13: Goa

Morning after breakfast you will be free for you independent activity in which you can spend time on the beaches of Goa. Overnight stay.

Day 14: Goa - Onwards

Morning after breakfast you will drive to the Goa airport to board your flight for onwards.
