

# WALES & SNOWDONIA – 03 DAYS

## Itinerary:

### **Day 1: London - Leicester – Penrhyn Castle – Chester**

Report at 1 designated place in London. On-board coach, pickup passenger en-route and proceed to Bangor. Visit Penrhyn Castle. Penrhyn Castle is a 19th century castle with Norman style architecture near Bangor in North Wales. This faux-Norman castle was constructed in the early 1800s and replaced an earlier fortified Medieval manor house. The interiors include a collection of neo-Norman furniture, ornate carvings and plasterwork and a large collection of artwork. Later transfer to restaurant. Dinner at restaurant followed by transfer to hotel. Check-in at hotel. Overnight stay.

### **Day 2: Chester – Snowdonia Train – Slate Museum – Chester**

After breakfast, proceed to Snowdonia National Park. Enjoy Mountain train at Snowdonia. Take a once in a lifetime adventure on the Snowdon Mountain Railway which has been described as one of the most scenic railway journeys in the world. Trains depart from Llanberis Station and begin their climb up Snowdon, Yr Wyddfa, a journey experienced by some 12 million travellers since 1896. With stunning scenery and awe-inspiring views it's all part of a great day out for you and your family



in North Wales. Later proceed to National Slate Museum. The National Slate Museum is located in the Victorian workshops built in the shadow of Elidir mountain, site of the vast Dinorwig quarry. Here you can travel into the past of an industry and a way of life that has chiselled itself into the very being of this country. Dinner at Restaurant. Overnight stay.

### Day 3: Chester – Llandudno Cable car – Leicester – London

After breakfast, check-out from hotel. Proceed to Llandudno. Enjoy Llandudno Cable car ride. As the Llandudno Cable Cars glide silently from Happy Valley to the summit of the Great Orme, 679 feet up, you can take in the jaw-dropping panoramic views of the Bay of Llandudno, the Little Orme, the Conwy Estuary and miles out over the Iris Sea. On-board coach and proceed back to London via Leicester.
