Day 1: LONDON TO LIMA

Depart from London Heathrow airport to Lima.

Day 2: ARRIVAL IN LIMA (D)

Arrival at Lima airport. Proceed for sightseeing. Enter the Roman Catholic Cathedral and appreciate a unique collection of sculptures and paintings from the 17th and 18th century. The tomb of the Spanish who conquered Peru, Francisco Pizarro, is kept inside the Cathedral. Then, visit the San Francisco Monastery and discover its underground maze of tunnels and catacombs. Finally, head to Lima's contemporary districts, Miraflores and San Isidro. Later transfer to hotel. Check-in at hotel. Overnight stay.

Day 3: LIMA - AREQUIPA (BY FLIGHT) (B/L/D)

After breakfast, check-out from hotel and transfer to airport for flight to Arequipa. Start your city tour by admiring the beautiful landscapes, fields, and pre-Inca terraces from the Yanahuara and Carmen Alto viewpoints. Then, visit Arequipa's most traditional neighborhood: San Lázaro. Finally, inside the Andean Sanctuaries Museum, learn about the frozen mummy Juanita. Later transfer to hotel. Check-in at hotel. Overnight stay.

Day 4: AREQUIPA - COLCA (B/L/D)

After breakfast, you will drive through the

Aguada Blanca National Park. Keep an eye out for herds of wild vicuñas, llamas, and alpacas. Then, reach the tour's highest viewpoint at 4,910m (16,108ft.) and appreciate the snow-capped peaks of the region's volcanoes like the Misti, Ampato and Sabancaya. After lunch in Chivay (3,658m/12,000ft.), you have the option to visit the local market.

Day 5: COLCA - AREQUIPA (B/L/D)

After an early breakfast, make your way to the "Cruz del Condor" viewpoint and appreciate the depths of the canyon. Afterwards, stop in the small towns of Maca and Yanque renowned for their small colonial churches and stunning landscapes. Continue your drive back to the White City and arrive in the late afternoon. Lunch at a local restaurant.

Day 6: AREQUIPA - CUSCO (BY FLIGHT) - URUBAMBA (B/D)

After breakfast, check-out from hotel and transfer to airport for flight to Cusco. Arrival to Cusco, Start your excursion today with a visit to the small town of Pisac. Later, it's time for shopping – a small picturesque street will give you a wide selection of Peruvian handicrafts: ceramics, paintings, weavings, and jewellery. Speaking of jewellery, explore the impressive ruins of Ollantaytambo, Later transfer to hotel. Check-in at hotel. Overnight stay.

Day 7: URUBAMBA - MACHU PICCHU - CUSCO (B/L/D)

You will be picked up at given time from your hotel and taken to the train station of Ollantaytambo. At the train station, board the panoramic train and enjoy the stunning Andean views filled with small communities and snow-capped mountains in the Sacred Valley. Learn about the Inca civilization, the site's discovery, and the different theories on this mysterious and spectacular archeological site. Temples, agricultural terraces, and archeological observatories enclose a history and a mystery that go back thousands of years. Take train back to Ollantaytambo from where you will be transferred to your hotel in Cusco.

Day 8: CUSCO SIGHTSEEING (B/L/D)

After breakfast, enjoy Cusco City tour. Plaza de Armas, Koricancha – The Temple dedicated to the Sun "Inti". Puca Pucara Fort and Inca Baths known as Tambomachay. walls until you reach Koricancha, the temple dedicated to the sun "Inti". End your tour at the Inca Baths known as Tambomachay and learn about the aqueducts and channels that allow the water to flow naturally. Royal Observatory and City Palace which is known to present a unique amalgam of Rajasthani and Mughal architecture. Later, back to the hotel for dinner and a comfortable overnight stay.

Day 9: CUSCO - PUNO (B/L/D)

After breakfast, check-out and proceed to Puno. Stopping at La Raya, Visit the Andahuaylillas Church, Explore the Raqchi ruins, Stop in the town of Pucará, Visit the "Museo Lítico de Pucará" (Pucará Stone Museum), and appreciate objects from this pre-Inca civilization. Overnight stay.

Day 10: PUNO - LA PAZ (B/L/D)

After breakfast, proceed to Kasani frontier. Arrival to Kasani on the border and cross into Bolivia. Assistance with migration formalities. From here, drive to Copacabana. Visit the small religious town and see the main square and the church. Then, embark on the eco-friendly catamaran and sail to the southern side of Sun Island. Arrive at the Pilcocaina temple, take a local motor boat and sail to the Yumani dock to visit the Eternal Youth Fountain and the Inca terraces. As you continue by catamaran. Arrival to Cocotoni dock place, transfer to La Paz and check in at your hotel.

Day 11: LA PAZ - UYUNI (BY FLIGHT) (B/D)

After breakfast, check-out from hotel. Transfer to airport for flight to Uyuni. Arrive at the Uyuni airport. Visit train cemetery, Colchani, Visit one of the village's salt plants and rustic workshops, Afterwards, cross the salt lake and see the salt eyes. Continue your tour to the Incahuasi Island, renowned for its gigantic cactus plants. Visit the Galaxy Caves. Overnight stay.

Day 12: UYUNI SIGHTSEEING (B/L/D)

After breakfast, visit Coqueza, Tunupa volcano, here, Visit the ruins of Pucara Ayque are situated on the edge of the Thunupa Volcano. drive back to Uyuni.

Day 13: UYUNI - LA PAZ (BY FLIGHT) (B/D)

After breakfast, check-out from hotel. Pickup and transfer to airport for flight to La Paz. Arrival at La Paz. Visit a local handicraft market and the famous Witches' Market. Pass by important historical buildings such as the San Francisco Colonial Church, Plaza Murillo, the Government Palace, and the National Congress. Pass by the residential districts of Obrajes, Calacoto, and La Florida. enjoy a moderate walk to the Moon Valley and appreciate its lunar landscapes and unique geological formations. End your tour with a ride up the world's highest cable car and marvel at the views over La Paz.

Day 14: LA PAZ SIGHTSEEING (B/L/D)

After breakfast, visit the ruins that were once the Tiwanaku culture's ceremonial and political center. The UNESCO World Heritage site is located at an altitude of 3,850m (12,631ft.) and dates back thousands of years. Visit the local museum before driving back to La Paz.

Day 15: LA PAZ - BUENOS AIRES (BY FLIGHT) (B/D)

After breakfast, check-out from hotel. Pickup and transfer to airport for flight to Buenos Aires. Transfer to hotel. Check-in at hotel. Overnight stay.

Day 16: BUENOS AIRES (B/L/D)

After breakfast, Visit Plaza de Mayo. Afterwards, in La Boca district, enjoy a short stroll along "Caminito" and admire the colorful streets filled with souvenir shops and Tango dancers. Recoleta Cemetery entrance fee. Take 1h - boat excursion (shared) along the Paraná Delta and its channels, rivers, streams, and numerous islands, appreciating the lush vegetation. Visit tango house to enjoy a dinner and show. Overnight stay.

Day 17: BUENOS AIRES - FOZ DO IGUASSU (BY FLIGHT) (B/D)

After breakfast, check-out and transfer to airport for flight to Puerto Iguazu. Leave your hotel in Brazil and drive to the Iguazú National Park in Argentina. From the visitor's center, take the train and go to the Upper Circuit (1,700m) as you appreciate the panoramic views of the falls. Arrive at the Devil's Throat, the park's most impressive and immense waterfalls. Measuring 150m (492ft.) long and 80m (262ft.).

Day 18: FOZ DO IGUASSU (B/L/D)

After breakfast, Drive to the Iguassu National Park. From here, walk along the paths and appreciate the lush vegetation, butterflies, and cascades. Take the 1,5km (1mi.) path that leads you to an amazing panoramic view of the Devil's Throat. The Bird Park is located 300m (984ft.) before the entrance of Brazilian National Park, an environmental area that combines ecological tourism and preservation.

Day 19: FOZ DO IGUASSU - RIO DE JANEIRO (BY FLIGHT) (B/D)

After breakfast, check-out and transfer to airport for flight to Rio de Janeiro. You will be welcomed at the Rio de Janeiro airport and driven to your hotel in the south zone. Leave your hotel and drive to Rio's downtown area for your city tour. See the National Library, the Municipal Theatre, the Candelaria Church, and the Cultural Center. Then, step inside the Metropolitan Cathedral and appreciate its unique architecture and beautiful interior with floor-to-ceiling stained glass windows. Overnight stay.

Day 20: RIO DE JANEIRO SIGHTSEEING (B/L/D)

After breakfast, visit Cosme Velho district, where you take a cogwheel train through the Tijuca forest up the Corcovado Mountain. Arrive at the top, admire the well-known Christ the Redeemer statue. End your tour at the Metropolitan Cathedral and appreciate its unique architecture and beautiful interior with floor-to-ceiling stained glass windows.

Day 21: RIO DE JANEIRO SIGHTSEEING (B/L/D)

After breakfast, head to the Fashion Mall Theatre for a show that combines Brazil's diversity and cultures Overnight stay.

Day 22: RIO DE JANEIRO - LONDON (B)

Leave your hotel in the south zone and drive to the airport for your flight.

Day 23: LONDON

Arrival at London Heathrow airport.
